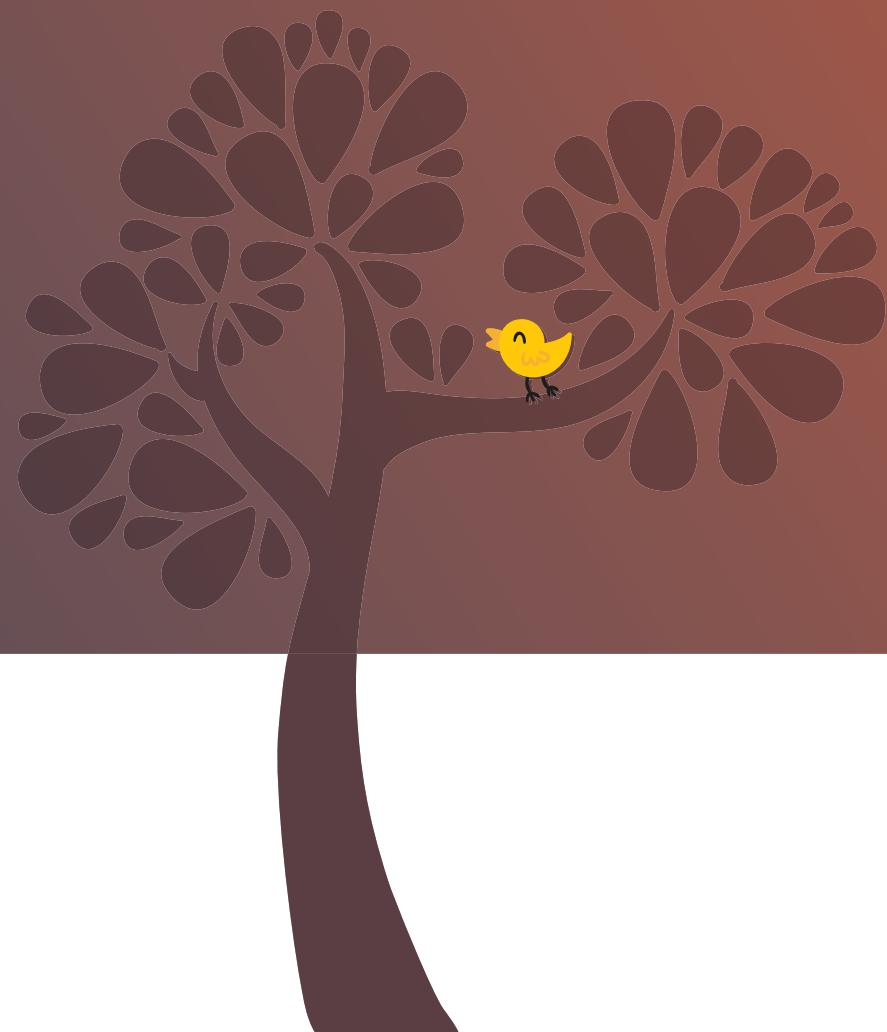

“For years I noticed emaciated, hungry looking, poorly clad Children and Women waiting at the entrance of the Central Prison, Seshadri Road, Bangalore on the way to my office - Reserve Bank of India, only to realise one day that these helpless people are stigmatized, self deprived and shunned by the society for no fault of theirs and their sole bread winner is serving life term inside the jail. Moved by their plight, I wanted to help these community of people in some measure. Being a salary earner with no other source of income, I had to wait for a couple of years till I got my superannuation benefits to start a **Home of Love** for these community of people.

Thus came into existence **Society's Care for Indigent (SOCARE IND)** in the year 1999. Rest, as they say, is History!”

The journey of Socare Ind

SOCARE IND is a Registered Trust. The Founder, Late Shri V. Mani, a retired Assistant General Manager, RBI ably and enthusiastically assisted by his wife Smt. Saroji Mani and some friends took a couple of children of Life Convicts for comprehensive care such as free shelter, food and education. He sheltered them in his small house. The NGO that had 4 children in the first year of operation sheltered 157 children during the reporting period under reference. Both Boys and Girls in the age group of 4 and 19 are the beneficiaries. Majority of them are first generation school-goers belonging to Minority Communities such as SC/ST or Minority Religions. Both Shri Mani and his wife Smt. Saroji Mani are no more. The affairs of the



Trust are now looked after mainly by a group of Senior Citizens, the friends of the Founder. Sri Sharada Peetam, Sringeri, looking at the genuineness of the cause and the passion and commitment of Shri. Mani and his team, came forward to assist SOCARE IND and adopted it as their Unit in the year 2007. Apart from sanctioning a monthly grant of Rs. 50,000 they also bought two house sites situated adjacent to the hostel building owned by SOCARE IND at Laggare Peenya, Bangalore and donated them to SOCARE IND for building a new hostel for Boys. The Boys' hostel with all the facilities like Dining Hall, Play area, Prayer Hall, Library Cum Computer lab, Modern Kitchen etc was commissioned in the year 2014.

Progress during the year

Currently a new hostel building exclusively for Girls is under construction after the old building in which Girls were staying was demolished. The hostel is expected to accommodate about 70 girls. The construction is expected to be over by end of December 2017.

As most of the children hail from Andhra and Karnataka Region, a branch hostel was set up in Gulbarga in the year 2011. During the period under reporting, 18 boys were sheltered in our Gulbarga hostel. This hostel is housed in a rented building and managed by a local committee. It is proposed to build a Hostel cum vocational training center at a residential site allotted by the Gulbarga Development Authority on long lease at a cost of Rs. 15 Lakhs. Recently a bore well at the site was

dug up and the construction of the building is expected to commence soon after the completion of the Girls Hostel building in Bangalore.

Registration of the Trust with the Child and Women Welfare Department (CWC)

SOCARE IND has been successful in obtaining registration from the CWC.

Educational Impact

Academic progress of children is closely monitored. Regular evening tuition classes are held in the hostel premises to enable the children to complete their home work etc., Student management portal is being developed for continuous and effective monitoring of the academic progress of the children.

Out of the total of 118 children studying from kindergarten to 10th standard in Bangalore. 47 children are girls and 71 are boys.

- One boy secured 1st class in BE, Mechanical Engineering
- One girl passed B.Com securing 80%
- A total of 18 children (13 boys / 5 Girls) appeared for 10th Board Exams. 15 children were successful

A graphical representation of the progress made by the children in academics.

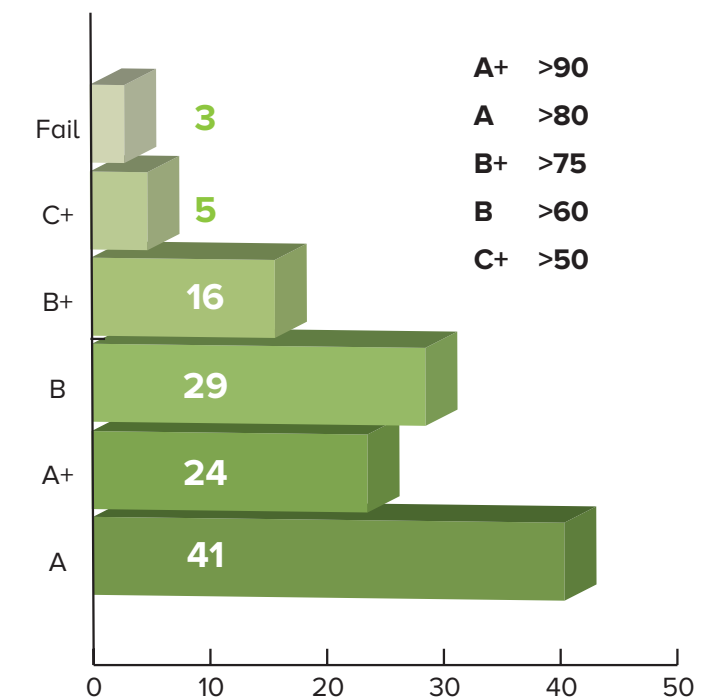

Governance

HR Policy

We are working on streamlining the administration by framing workable HR solutions and rules and regulations. We are considering to enroll the Staff members for National Pension Scheme.

- All the children and the staff members are given new dresses for Diwali.
- We are also in the process of improving our IT infrastructure for streamlining our day to operations and reduce the human intervention in avoidable areas to ensure efficiency.

Children Recruitment and Relieving Policy

While recruitment of children of prisoners continues to be our first priority, the second/alternate rung of children may consist of those who are closely inter-related by blood to the families of prisoners. However, a few exceptions are made in very deserving cases referred to us either by the CWC or any well wisher of our Organization.

Students' Focus

Besides education, an equal importance was given to extracurricular activities of the children. Enthusiasm of the children in overall self-development is reflected in their participation and winning the prizes in various competitions.

We are proud to highlight some important achievements of our children.

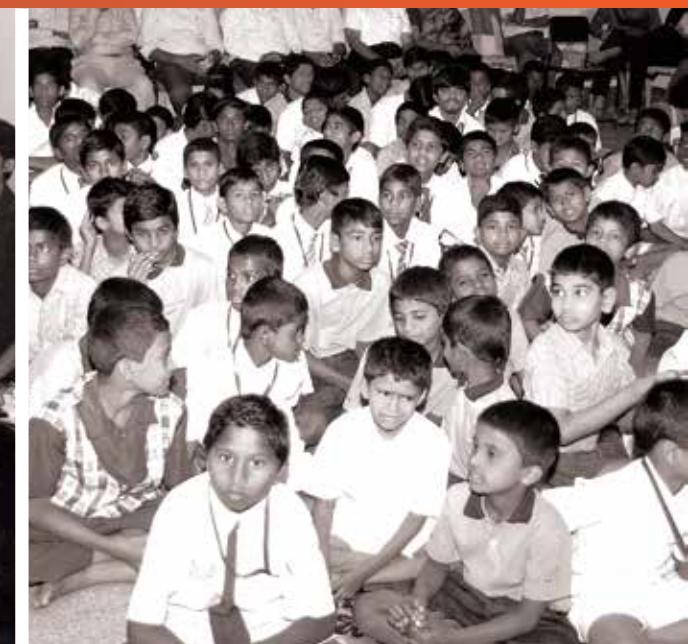
Alumni Connect

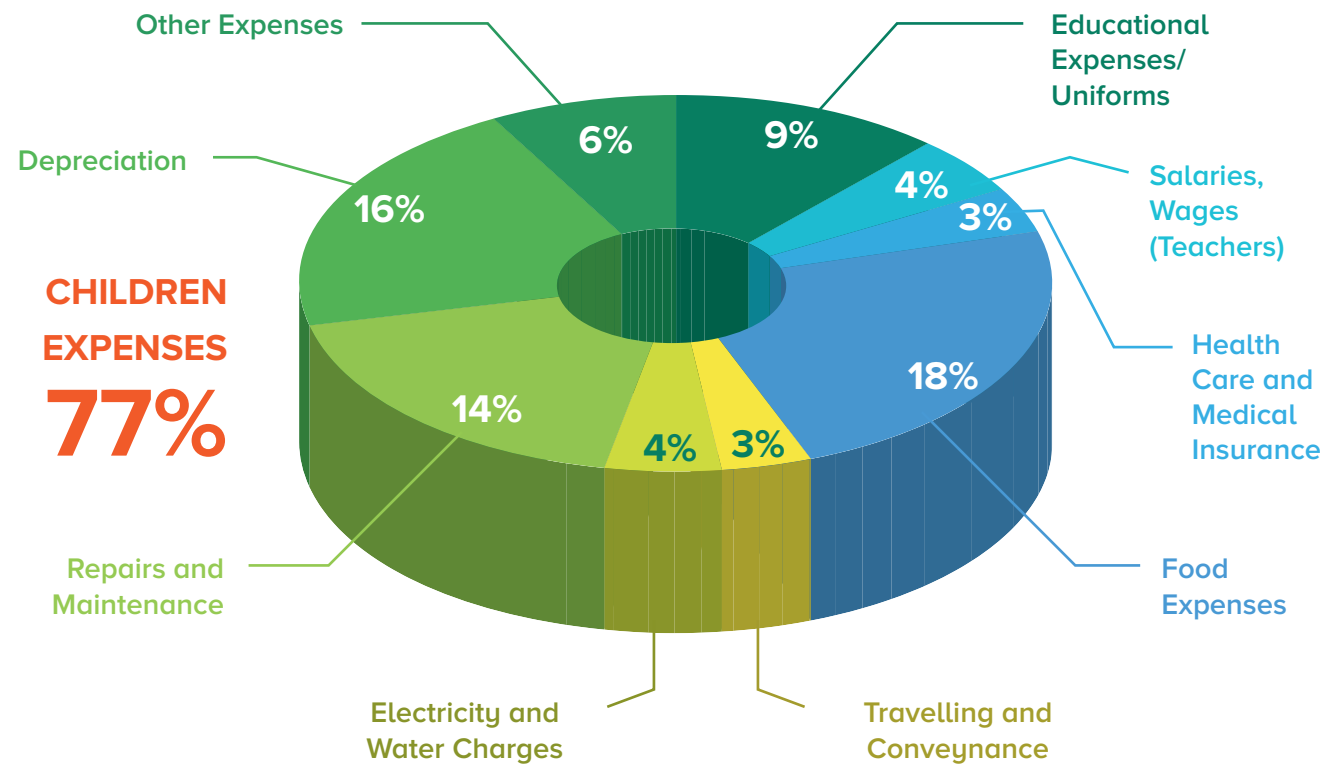

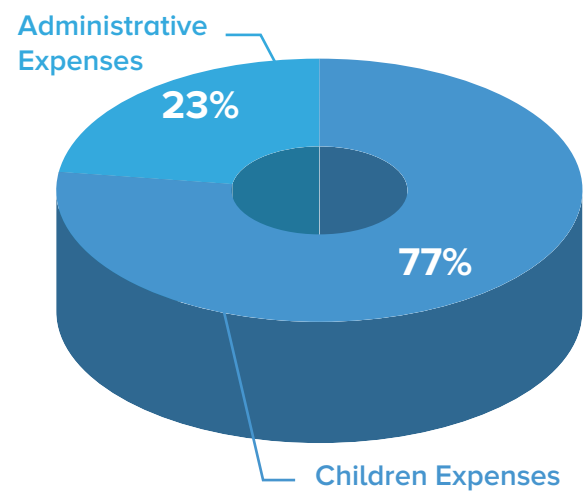

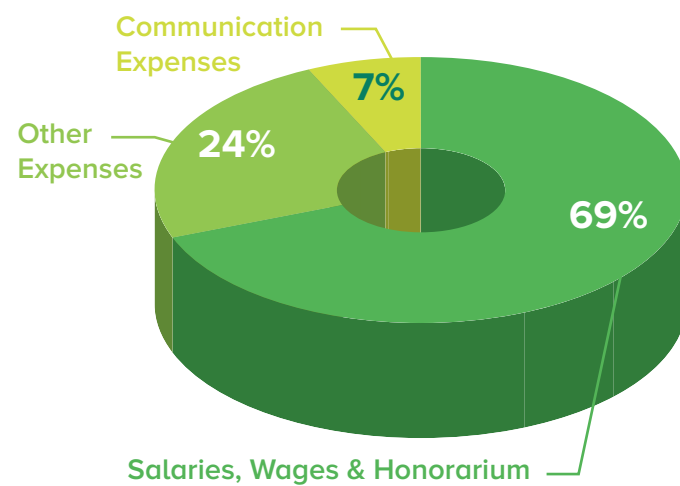
A detailed graphics indicating the amounts spent on each segment is given below:
